As more than 5,000 participants from the surrounding areas Race for the Cure, they will help Komen Northeast Ohio turn Cleveland into a sea of pink. The Race is an opportunity for women, men and children of all ages to come together to celebrate survivors and honor those who have lost their battle with the disease.

Susan G. Komen Northeast Ohio has a significant impact on our community. During the last year, almost 35,000 services were provided to just over 16,000 individuals through grant dollars provided by Komen Northeast Ohio to organizations that serve uninsured or underinsured people that cannot access the care they need. The services that Komen grant dollars provide range from education to clinical breast exams, mammograms, diagnostic procedures, patient navigation, transportation, and survivor support. By investing the dollars raised in Northeast Ohio back in to our community, we can ensure that the highest quality of service is being provided to people most in need.

Whether you walk, run, volunteer or donate, your support helps save lives and provides priceless support to those in need. "The Race helps provide significant funds and bring critical breast cancer resources, like free mammograms and low-cost diagnostic procedures, to the low-income, underinsured, and uninsured in our local community," said Sean Shacklett, Executive Director of Komen Northeast Ohio. "Every dollar makes a difference. Each participant is making a direct impact in the fight against breast cancer in Northeast Ohio."

Through events like the Komen Cleveland Race for the Cure, Komen Northeast has provided \$15 million in grants to more than 50 local organizations that serve the most vulnerable populations in our community. In 2017, six organizations received close to \$300,000 in grants for programs dedicated to serving those most in need in the local community. Additionally, more than \$5 million has been contributed to the Susan G. Komen Research and Training Grants Program.
